

## **DIRECTIONS TO LOW RAISGILL**

### **Walking from Hubberholme on the Dales Way**

In Hubberholme immediately after The George Inn on the left, cross the bridge to the North side of the River Wharfe.

After crossing the bridge keep going roughly straight ahead down the farm track that takes you around to the back of the church where you will find a finger post direction for the Dales Way. Take the track that follows the river upstream, keeping on the main track, for about 1 mile.



Apart from some small stone barns, the first buildings and habitation you come to is Yockenthwaite.

### **Yockenthwaite (from the south)**

From the track below the main house and above the cottage at Yockenthwaite, you can see the stone bridge over the River Wharfe.



### **Yockenthwaite Bridge from the Dales Way**

Cross the bridge onto the South side of the river, turn left and follow the surfaced road across the common for five minutes. Cross the cattle grid and Low Raisgill is the second house on the right.

### **Directions by car from Buckden**

If travelling from the south (Grassington and Skipton) on the B6160, turn left at Buckden village green on the small road signposted to Hubberholme. After 1 mile drive through Hubberholme, past The George Inn on your left.

After a further 1.25 miles of countryside Low Raisgill is the first house on your left. If you cross the cattle grid onto the common you have gone too far! Please park in front of the fenced shrubbery to the side of our garage.

If travelling from the north (West Burton and Leyburn) ) on the B6160, you can either turn right at Buckden village green and follow the directions above, or take a short cut by turning right on the small road (no signpost) about 300 metres after the White Lion at Cray.

Turn right again at the T junction which takes you to Hubberholme. Turn right after crossing the bridge by The George Inn. After a further 1.25 miles of countryside Low Raisgill is the first house on your left.

### **Directions by car from Hawes**

From the centre of Hawes take the A684 westwards towards Kendal and within 300 metres turn left to Gayle and Kettlewell just by the Wensleydale Creamery. Keep following the signs to Kettlewell and keep on the same road all the way for about 9 miles.

You go over Fleet Moss on the highest road in Yorkshire, drop down into Oughtershaw and follow the growing River Wharfe. After the sharp left turn at Beckermonds the road runs immediately next to the Wharfe, first on the north bank and then on the south bank.

After passing the arched bridge to Yokenthwaite on your left, the road climbs slightly and crosses a cattle grid. Low Raisgill is the second house on your right immediately after the cattlegid. Please park in front of the fenced shrubbery to the side of our garage.
